

2023 Redwood Area Education Foundation "Back to School Foundation Raffle" Raffle House Rules

1. **RAFFLE OFFICIAL RULES:** By participating, entrants agree to be bound by these Official Rules and by the decision of Sponsor, which shall be binding and final as to all matters related to the Redwood Area Education Foundation Back to School – Fund the Foundation raffle (the "Raffle"). The Raffle is subject to all applicable federal, state and local laws.
2. **SPONSOR:** Redwood Area Education Foundation, 100 George Ramseth Drive, Redwood Falls, MN 56283 ("Sponsor"). Permit # X95055-23-002
3. **NET PROCEEDS:** All net proceeds of the Raffle will benefit Sponsor, a 501(c)(3) organization, and the programs that Sponsor supports.
4. **ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER:** Persons under age 18 may not purchase a raffle ticket or win a raffle prize. All persons eligible, regardless of their state of residence, may purchase Raffle tickets, but prize pickup is in Redwood Falls, Minnesota. All Prizes, besides cash or certificates, will not be shipped. Gambling Manager (Rachael Buyck) is not eligible to win. Gambling Manager's immediate family, persons involved in conduct (selling raffle tickets), RAEF board of directors and immediate families, volunteers involved in event where drawing is to be held are all eligible to win.
5. **ENTRY PERIOD:** The Raffle entry period is between 8:00 a.m. Central Time (CT) on August 18, 2023 ("Start Date"), through 11:59 p.m. on November 24, 2023 ("Entry Period"). A maximum of 350 tickets will be sold. The drawing will be held on November 25, 2023. The purchase of only one ticket is required to enter the raffle. Completed raffle tickets must be in the possession of a Redwood Area Education Foundation representative prior to the drawing on November 24, 2023 to be eligible for the Raffle.
6. **PURCHASING RAFFLE ENTRIES:** Raffle tickets may be purchased for one hundred dollars (\$100.00) each, by eligible persons (see "ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER" above). Each ticket is sold for the same price. Tickets may be purchased by cash, check or debit card payment during the Entry Period specified above. Raffle tickets may be purchased in accordance with these Official Rules either at the Redwood Area Education Foundation office, from any Redwood Area Education Foundation board member or any of the participating in-person locations starting August 18, 2023. All ticket purchases are final and non-refundable. If a check or debit card payment is dishonored by the bank, the RAEF will attempt to contact the individual for proper payment. Raffle prizes will not be awarded until a check or debit card payment clears the bank. Only ONE name should be stated on the raffle ticket. In the event a winning entry has more than one name listed on the ticket, RAEF will physically award the prize to the first name listed on the entry. Neither RAEF, its Board of Directors, staff or their legal counsel are responsible for resolving disputes which may arise from any conflict between or amongst joint ticket holders or purchasers.
7. **TRANSFER/RESALE OF RAFFLE ENTRIES:** Persons who purchase Raffle tickets may opt to give away or otherwise transfer their Raffle tickets to others, but in doing so they give up any claim they might otherwise have to the Prize if they surrender a winning Raffle ticket.
8. **PRIZES:** A complete list of additional prizes is available upon request.
For Grand Prize ATV: Exact model, color and options of vehicle and exact vehicle to be awarded are at the sole discretion of Sponsor and subject to availability from manufacturer. Official Winner is responsible for vehicle registration, license, title and insurance fees and any other expenses related to the acceptance and use of the prize not specified herein.
Grand Prize Winner shall bear all risk of loss or damage to his/her ATV after he/she has taken delivery of ATV. EXCEPT AS STATED IN THE MANUFACTURER'S LIMITED WARRANTY FOR THE VEHICLE, THE RELEASED PARTIES MAKE NO WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, IN FACT OR IN LAW, RELATIVE TO THE USE OR ENJOYMENT OF THE ATV, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, THEIR QUALITY, MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.
9. **NOTIFICATION OF POTENTIAL WINNERS:** Owners of eligible entries need not be present in person on the Drawing Date in order to win. Sponsor will endeavor to contact the winning entry ("potential winner") by phone or email immediately after the Drawing, to notify such person that he/she is the potential winner, but only if and to the extent that Sponsor can successfully identify and contact such potential winner based on the identifying and contact information supplied by the entrant of the entry in question. **POTENTIAL WINNER MUST CONTACT SPONSOR TO CLAIM HIS/HER PRIZE NO LATER THAN December 8th, 2023, (10) BUSINESS DAYS AFTER THE APPLICABLE DRAWING DATE** (the owner of the winning ENTRY will have until December 8th, 2023 to claim his/her Prize). If the potential winner has not claimed his/her Prize by following the procedures noted above and have not claimed the Prize by December 8th, on the tenth (10th) business day after the applicable

original Drawing Date, he/she shall no longer be eligible to win the applicable Prize and a new potential winner will be selected from among all remaining eligible entries received as of the applicable Drawing Date Deadline. The same drawing, posting and notification procedures will be used. If the Prize/Grand Prize is not claimed by December 8th, 2023, on the tenth (10th) business day following the applicable new Drawing Date, the procedures in the preceding sentence will be repeated until an eligible entrant properly claims the Prize in the proper manner and within the proper time constraints.

10. DETERMINATION OF WINNERS: Sponsor shall have the sole discretion to determine whether the potential winners are Winners. Winner will be determined by a random drawing on November 25, 2023 at the Dollars for Scholars Alumni Game Day Event. Sponsor's decision concerning the identity of a Winner shall be final and binding. To become a Winner; (1) a potential winner must be eligible to participate in the Raffle under these Official Rules as determined in Sponsor's sole judgement; (2) that potential winner must contact Sponsor, or be contacted by Sponsor, within 10 business days of drawing date; (3) that potential winner's winning entry must be inspected and verified by Sponsor; (4) that potential winner must provide Sponsor with identification information. If for any reason whatsoever all of the foregoing requirements are not satisfied with respect to a particular potential winner, or if Sponsor is unable for any reason to identify the entrant or contact a potential winner, then that potential winner's Prize will be deemed forfeited and, at Sponsor's sole discretion, an alternate potential winner of that Prize will be selected, through another random drawing from among all remaining eligible entries received as of the application Drawing Date Deadline in accordance with the procedures noted in "Notification of Potential Winners" above. Name of the winner will be available to the media and all raffle participants, displayed on the Redwood Area Education Foundation website and at the Foundation office located at 100 George Ramseth Drive, Redwood Falls, Minnesota 56283.
11. AWARD OF PRIZES TO OFFICIAL WINNERS: All prizes will be awarded to the prize Winners and presented at the Dollars for Scholars Alumni Game Day event, determined by Sponsor at its sole discretion. Prize Winners must accept his/her prizes in person, unless Sponsor approves, in its sole discretion, other arrangements for the delivery. Winner shall be solely responsible for their own transportation and other travel costs and lodging associated with accepting their prize.
12. TAXES: The Winner will assume sole responsibility for all federal, state and local taxes, title, registration, local license and transportation fees associated with the ATV. The taxable value of the Prizes will be treated as ordinary income to the Winners for federal and state tax purposes, and each Winner will be required by law to pre-pay a portion of the tax liability incurred in connection with his/her receipt for the applicable Prize before receiving his/her Prize from Sponsor.
13. RELEASE OF LIABILITY: Entrants, by participating in the Raffle, agree that the Redwood Area Education Foundation, RAEF board of directors, affiliates, partners, subsidiaries, agents, representatives, sponsors, service agencies and independent contractors and each of their respective directors, officers, partners, employees and agents, including advertising and promotion agencies, will have no liability whatsoever for, and shall be held harmless by entrants against, any liability for injuries, losses, costs, expenses or damages of any kind, including damages for death, personal injury, property damage or property loss, resulting from, whether in whole or in part or directly or indirectly, participation in this Raffle or the acceptance, possession, misuse or use of any entry or Prizes awarded.
14. PUBLICITY RELEASE: Each Winner, by accepting his/her Prize, grants Sponsor and Sponsor's designees and affiliates, including The Redwood Area Education Foundation full permission, except where legally prohibited, to use that Winner's name, address (city and state only), photograph, voice and/or other likeness and prize information for advertising, trade and promotional purposes without further compensation and without notice, review or approval, in all media now known or thereafter discovered, worldwide, and on the Internet and world wide web, in perpetuity.
15. GOVERNING LAW: The Raffle and these Official Rules shall be subject to and governed by the laws of the State of Minnesota.
